Dear Mr. President,

Congratulations on your election! Please know that I have delayed mailing this letter until your inauguration, as most of my previous emails and portal messages have been ignored. This lack of response is owned by your predecessor, my senators and congressman, the CEOs of most major airlines, the UN Secretary General, climate experts, and others. I wrote the Vice President about this matter via her Senate portals immediately before and after your election and have received no reply to date.
